Its primary role is to direct and coordinate international health within the United Nations system. Its main areas of work are health systems, health through the life-course, non communicable and communicable diseases, preparedness, surveillance and response, and corporate services.

UNICEF is a United Nations agency responsible for providing humanitarian and developmental aid to children worldwide. The agency is among the most widespread and recognisable social welfare organizations in the world, with a presence in 192 countries and territories. UNICEF's activities include providing immunisations and disease prevention, administering treatment for children and mothers with HIV, enhancing childhood and maternal nutrition, improving sanitation, promoting education, and providing emergency relief in response to disasters.
